

CHECKLIST FOR ALL JUDGMENTS OF DIVORCE	
	GENERAL PROVISIONS
<input type="checkbox"/>	Fails to address the insurance and/or dower provisions required by MCL 552.101
<input type="checkbox"/>	Fails to address the rights of the parties in pension/annuity/retirement benefits. MCL 552.101(4)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Fails to determination the property rights of the parties.
<input type="checkbox"/>	No provision reserving or denying spousal support, if spousal support is not granted.
<input type="checkbox"/>	No provision for notifying FOC of address change of child(ren) and parents.
	CUSTODY PROVISIONS
<input type="checkbox"/>	Missing the Inherent Rights of the child. MCL 722.24
<input type="checkbox"/>	Missing the Domicile Provision that states the minor child may not be moved from Michigan without the approval of the Judge who awarded custody or the Judge's successor and may not be moved outside of 100 miles from the parties' existing addresses unless pursuant to MCL 722.31 and MCR 3.211(C).
<input type="checkbox"/>	Missing the Legal Residence Provision that any change in legal residence must be in compliance with section 11 of the Child Custody Act of 1970, 1970 PA 91, MCL 722.31. (joint legal custody)
	PARENTING TIME PROVISIONS
<input type="checkbox"/>	The language describing parenting time is confusing and must be revised.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>The language describing parenting time is not specific enough for the FOC to enforce. Please revise this section if the parties want an enforceable schedule.</p> <p>Note: This will not prevent the order from being approved, however, the order must state that "The parties acknowledge that the parenting time schedule is unenforceable as written and either party may file a motion to modify parenting time should he or she wish to have a more specific schedule."</p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	The order must contain a prohibition on parenting time in nations that are not a party to the Hague Convention on the Civil Aspects of International Child Abduction or written consent to allow. Public Act 600 of 2012.
	OPT OUT PROVISIONS:
<input type="checkbox"/>	Direct payment of child support requires parties to Opt Out of FOC services. MCL 552.505a
<input type="checkbox"/>	Opting out of FOC services requires filing of a motion and an Advice of Rights form, signed by both parties.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Opt Out findings and language pursuant to MCL 552.505a must be in a separate order, or all required language must be in the final order/judgment.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Opt Out is prohibited in cases where any party is receiving cash assistance, Medicaid, or food assistance. Opt out is also prohibited if past due support is owed to the State.
	CHILD SUPPORT PROVISIONS:
<input type="checkbox"/>	Box must be checked at the top of the UCSO to indicate this is the "final" order.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Box must be checked describing how the order is entered (after hearing/by stipulation or consent)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Box must be checked to indicate that calculations are attached to the UCSO (Calculations must be attached). MCL 552.505(1)(h).
<input type="checkbox"/>	The Payer's name, Payee's name, Child(ren)'s name, or number of overnights is missing/incorrect.
<input type="checkbox"/>	The effective date is missing or incorrect.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Fails to order Ordinary Medical pursuant to the Formula.

<input type="checkbox"/>	The percentages of uninsured health care expenses are missing or incorrect. You may not exceed 90% or be less than 10%.
<input type="checkbox"/>	The Annual Ordinary Medical for each child is missing or incorrect.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Box is checked for post-majority support, but the child's name and the month/year of expected graduation is missing.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Child's name and the month/year of graduation are listed but you have not checked the box next to "Post-majority Support."
<input type="checkbox"/>	Order fails to require one/both parties to provide health care coverage. MCL 552.605a Note: If you check the box next to both plaintiff <u>AND</u> defendant, it means "both" not "either/or." FOC will send an order to the employer of each party requiring that the child be added to insurance coverage.
	DEVIATION PROVISIONS:
<input type="checkbox"/>	Case is not eligible for deviation due to active public assistance.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Box must be checked to indicate support is a deviation from the Michigan Child Support Formula.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Box 12 is checked but Deviation Addendum was not submitted.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Deviation Addendum not prepared correctly.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Fails to show Child Support amount per the Michigan Child Support Formula. MCL 552.605(2)(a)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Fails to describe how the child support ordered on page 1 is different from the Formula. MCL 552.605(2)(b)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Fails to specify why setting support pursuant to the Formula would be unjust or inappropriate. MCL 552.605(2)(d))
